Discipline: Minimum penalties applicable to all school activities

Disciplinary actions/consequences are determined on a case-by-case basis, subject to school administration investigation.

Penalties as coded below:

SS:	As stated in the Safe Schools Policies and Procedures
A:	Driving privileges revoked for up to one quarter
B:	Driving privileges revoked for balance of school year
C:	Police action
D:	Recommended expulsion
E:	Restitution
F:	Notification of Prosecutor's office and Counselor
G:	Confiscation (Return to parent)
H:	Suspension from bus for a period up to 180 days
M/5:	Mandatory 5-day suspension, concurrently served as Emergency Expulsion
1:	Suspension 1 day
3:	Suspension 3 days
5:	Suspension 5 days
7:	Suspension 7 days
10:	Suspension 10 days
15:	Suspension 15 days
90:	Suspension 90 days
